Restored by INTACH as a private residence for Francis Wacziarg, founder of Neemrana Hotels, Thanga House is an elegant 100-year-old 4-bedroom traditional Tamil house that welcomes guests to Tranquebar, India's first Danish trading post.

Located just over 100 km south of Pondicherry but only a few steps from the ocean, its tall, breezy terrace overlooks the palm-fringed beach, a perfect place to watch the sun rise over the horizon. This three-level villa, which you can book by individual rooms, is divided into two buildings, separated by an expansive courtyard.

You can spend your day touring the various heritage sites in Tranquebar and its surrounding towns, such as Fort Dansborg, the second-largest fort the Danes built in the world. Nearby is the famous temple of Thirukadaiyur, popular for 60th anniversary celebrations, and the Saneeswara Temple at Thirunallar. At night, you can cool off in our plunge pool to prepare for the next day.

While the house is exclusively vegetarian, we can arrange a sumptuous food tour in neighbouring Karaikal, featuring a smorgasbord from our favourite Islamic and Tamil non-vegetarian dining establishments to feast on.









THE STORY OF THANGA HOUSE

In the post-tsunami devastation of Tranquebar, the Government of Denmark and non-profit institutions set about restoring the colonial and Tamil quarter of the village to recreate a bygone era. Among these institutions was INTACH, which restored two rows of ancient Tamil houses to serve as multi-use community spaces. One of these caught the eye of Francis Wacziarg, co-founder of Neemrana Hotels, and he purchased and restored it as his private residence.

Because Thanga House was born through this partnership of Francis and INTACH, stepping into the lime plaster walls of Thanga House transports you back to a design ethos that merges Danish and Tamil styles. Signature peaked, tiled roofs cover each room, supported by sturdy wooden beams. The rosewood beds complement the rest of the house's teak and cane furniture, lending to a picturesque antique atmosphere you'll fall in love with.

The ethos of Thanga House revolves around finding an understated luxury in simplicity. Thanga House stands today as an imprint of the often-forgotten town's roots, a fitting destination for a historical and religious retreat.

Originally Francis Wacziarg's personal room when he built the house, the Platinum Room is an expansive bedroom attached to a quaint balcony that looks out onto the courtyard and plunge pool. An elegant antique four-poster bed, grand desk and wooden floor chest provide the focal points of the room.



Located on the ground floor of the rear block, the romantic

Silver Room leads out into its own private garden and plunge pool, making it ideal for couples seeking privacy and a romantic evening meal.





The Gold & Diamond Rooms are located on the first and second floors of the rear block.


Each of the rooms are decorated with period furniture and have private sit-outs with a view of the green canopy and glimpses of the Bay of Bengal.










The balcony of the Gold Room



- Thanga House does not permit nonvegetarian food on the premises. We do not serve alcoholic beverages.
- Senior travellers should note that there are
 no elevators to reach upper-floor rooms.
 Beds in some rooms have high clearance,
 so please take care when climbing into or
 out of them, especially in the dark.
- Tranquebar's places of worship broadcast their rituals & prayers with great fervour from dawn to dusk and beyond. Add in the cacophony from roosting peafowl in the house and its surroundings that rival these broadcasts. Ear plugs are available in every room.
- Set in a tropical haven and surrounded by lush greenery, the house attracts flies, ants and other bugs. Any food left open in the bedrooms or common spaces will also attract bugs. These insects attract bats, frogs, and geckos. Remember to keep all doors & windows shut to keep critters out.
- The marble-lined courtyard plunge pool is not meant for diving. Families should supervise young children in the pool at all times, as there is no lifeguard.
- Tharangambadi Beach is located under the thickest layer of ozone in India, offering sunbathers extra protection from UV radiation.






HOW TO SPEND YOUR TIME IN TRANQUEBAR

- Unwind with a relaxing walk along the jetty & join the morning live seafood auction
- Experience Tranquebar's rich Danish history with guided heritage walks. Visit Fort Dansborg, the second-largest fort the Danes built in the world.
 Explore its museum to learn about the landmark's history, such as establishing the first printing press in India and its importance in the spice trade.
- Visit the CSI Zion Church, said to be one of the first Protestant churches in India and explore the various restored buildings on Kings Street.
- Sunbathe on the Tharangambadi Beach.
- Ease your business & health concerns by prayer at the 800-year-old Masilamani Nathar Temple.
- Visit the Sri Renuga Devi Amman Temple, a 700year-old Hindu temple on the edge of the sea.

- Admire the Indian accents in the typically Danish construction of the New Jerusalem Church. Built out of teak wood from the Jaffna Dutch Ceylon, the church was made to resemble the Holy Cross.
- Take a half-day trip to Chidambaram to pay tribute to Lord Shiva at Chidambaram Temple in the heart of the town.
- Boat the second-largest mangrove forest in the world in Pichavaram, just 2 hours from the villa.
- Sample some of the best Islamic and Tamil nonvegetarian cuisine on our food tour of Karaikal.
- Visit Thirukadaiyur, whose temple is a renowned location for 60th marriage ceremonies.
- Pay tribute to Lord Saneeswaran at the Thirunallar Temple and visit the Budhan and Ketu Navagraha temples near Poompuhar.
