

Most importantly, come home to Vayal, to relish the lip-smacking cuisine that makes Chettinad world famous, as our all-women team, turn out delicious banana leaf spreads sourced from the farm and surroundings. 
THE STORY OF VAYAL

Vayal as the name symbolises, is set in a 3.5 acre organic farm that is part paddy field and part mango orchard. In the summer of 2019, the house was built as a family retreat, to escape the chaos of the urban cityscape, as well as to have a separate contemporary home when they congregated at the ancestral family mansion in their village of Sakkottai for festivals and special occasions.

Chettinad has a rich history of architecture, filled with mansions that have south Indian vernacular to art deco influences. The attempt was to create a space that took inspiration from their ancestral design but changed it to the needs of a modern family. A house that would fit right into the farm, something that feels like it had always been a part of the surrounding.

As the architects and their family used the house infrequently, they thought it would be fun to open out the space to discerning travellers with a passion for architecture and design, to enjoy this unique home, and be able to experience the sheer delight of slow life.






THE DESIGN ETHOS

The design goal for Vayal was to craft a building rather than building one. A walk through the mango orchard of Vayal's 3.5 acre farm was enough to identify a patch of land for the house to nest amidst the trees and designing the spaces to envelope them.

Although inspired by the mansions of Chettinad, the design of Vayal was straightforward. It consists of four blocks - bedroom chambers, kitchen and study and a semi basement with a plunge pool on top, all placed around a large central courtyard. The approach to the house from the main gate was purposefully made lengthy so that one could get into slow life mode. The bedrooms have their own private sit outs and study which give guests the option of secluding themselves. The indoor dining lounge was kept in the north east corner, visually away from the central courtyard so that one could retreat there in peace. The plunge tank has been raised from the ground to provide the swimmer a view of the surrounding tree line.

The decision to make an exposed brick house was inspired by the soil of the site, and the architects wanted the house to feel like a part of the visual landscape rather than standing out from it. Doors and windows were made of steel which helped create large spans of openings with thinner sections. The walls and floors had pigmented IPS floors, cuddapah inlays, mosaic and stone, all inspired by the myriad of colours used in the regional Athangudi tiles and the handloom industry.






HOW TO SPEND YOUR TIME AT VAYAL
